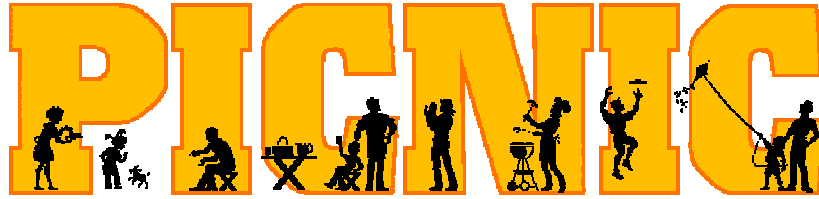
Our club has several great events coming up that the membership requested. Please review the BBQ information and Molly Winton's web site. See you on September 12<sup>th</sup>.

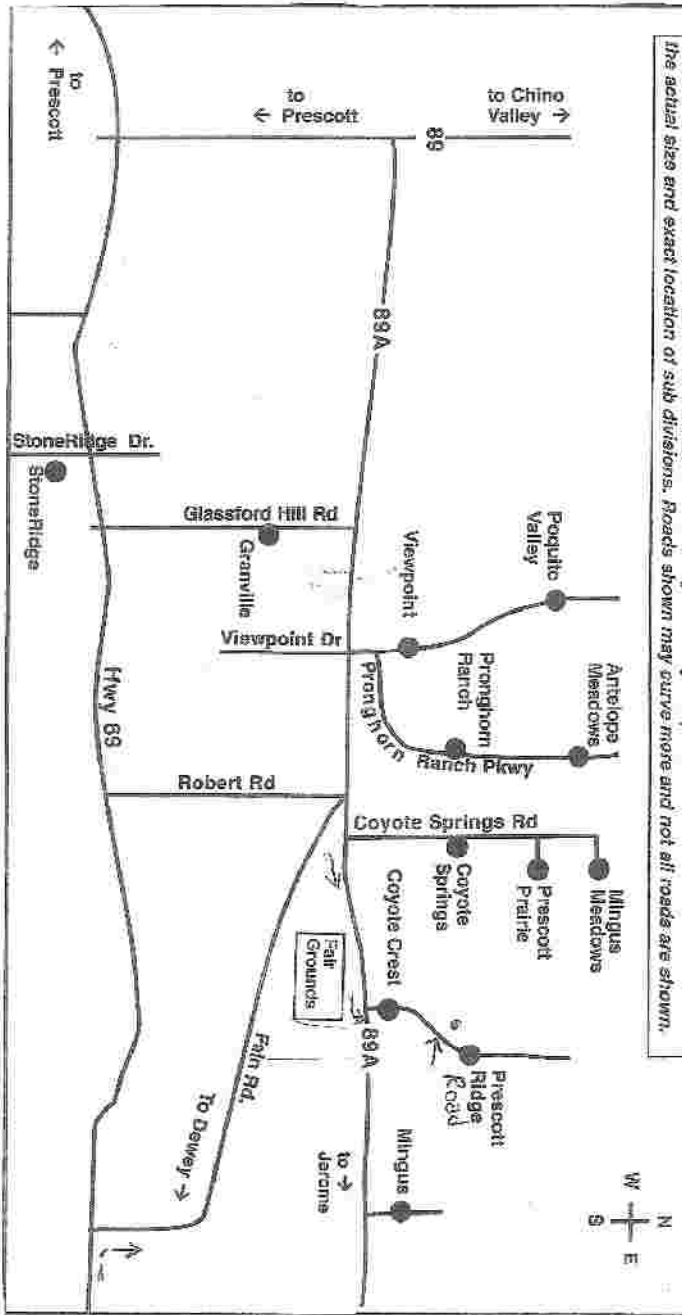
